THEME FOR TODAY

Singing songs is a big part of our traditions during this time of year. Christmas songs are some our favorite and most familiar songs. Singing songs of joy is nothing new. In fact, we see in the Bible how believers sang songs of joy in response to good news from God. This Advent, we’ll take a look at the songs of Advent joy found in the Scriptures: the Benedictus sung by Zechariah, the father of John the Baptist; the Magnificat, sung by Mary the mother of our Lord after being told the good news about the child she would bear; and the Gloria in Excelsis, sung by the angels who appeared to the shepherds on the night of Jesus birth.
