This Advent, we'll take a look a the songs of Advent joy found in the Scriptures: the Benedictus sung by Zechariah, the father of John the Baptist; the Magnificat, sung by Mary the mother of our Lord after being told the good news about the child she would bear; and the Gloria in Excelsis, sung by the angels who appeared to the shepherds on the night of Jesus birth.




Hymn of Light


Prayer of the Day


Lord's Prayer
