

#### WELCOME!

Welcome to Prince of Peace Lutheran Church. We pray that the time spent here in God's house helps you to appreciate how dearly God loves you! He invested the life blood of his one and only Son into your salvation and offers the blessings of that sacrifice to us through Word and Sacrament! May God bless our worship today!

#### THEME FOR TODAY

In the first half of the Church Year (Advent through Pentecost) we look at the life of Christ—his birth, ministry, death, resurrection, ascension, and the sending of the Holy Spirit. In the second half of the year, we look at the teachings of Christ. We begin by looking at one of the most mind-blowing truths: that God is triune. Already in the very first chapter of the Bible we read, "Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image..." (Genesis 1:26). Note the singular "God" and the plural "us." Scripture teaches us that there is only one God but that he exists as three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He is triune (three-in-one). This teaching is not some logical exercise or philosophical excursion. The doctrine of the Trinity is central to our salvation. The triune God is our Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier. Lose this doctrine, and as the Athanasian Creed says, you lose it all. A Jesus who is less than God is also less than a Savior. So often, when life gets hard, we get frustrated. We don't understand how God is working always for our good. But the doctrine of the Trinity teaches us we cannot even comprehend God's existence. How then, could we ever comprehend all his workings? On this Holy Trinity Sunday, let it be enough to know that all three persons—Father, Son, and Spirit—love us with an everlasting love.

#### LORD'S SUPPER

Scripture teaches us that in the Lord's Supper:

- The body and blood of Christ are really present with the bread and the wine. (Matthew 26:26-28; 1 Corinthians 11:27)
- Jesus gives true forgiveness, not just a symbol, to each recipient. (Matthew 26:28)
- We are united as one body of believers because we all partake the one body and blood of Christ. "Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all share the one loaf. (1 Corinthians 10:16-17)

For these reasons we ask that, if you are not a part of a WELS (Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod) or ELS (Evangelical Lutheran Synod) church that publicly confesses to believe these same scriptural truths, you speak with our pastor before you take the Sacrament. We do not wish to judge your faith, but want to make sure that we are in agreement before publicly declaring that we share a common faith.

We are careful about the way we celebrate the Lord's Supper because we want to humbly accept this gift the way God intended.



First Reading Genesis 1:1—2:3

The triune God demonstrates his power at Creation.

<sup>1</sup>In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup>Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

<sup>3</sup>And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. <sup>4</sup>God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. <sup>5</sup>God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day. <sup>6</sup>And God said, "Let there be a vault between the waters to separate water from water." <sup>7</sup>So God made the vault and separated the water under the vault from the water above it. And it was so. <sup>8</sup>God called the vault "sky." And there was evening, and there was morning—the second day.

<sup>9</sup>And God said, "Let the water under the sky be gathered to one place, and let dry ground appear." And it was so. <sup>10</sup>God called the dry ground "land," and the gathered waters he called "seas." And God saw that it was good.

<sup>11</sup>Then God said, "Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds." And it was so. <sup>12</sup>The land produced vegetation: plants bearing seed according to their kinds and trees bearing fruit with seed in it according to their kinds. And God saw that it was good. <sup>13</sup>And there was evening, and there was morning—the third day.

<sup>14</sup>And God said, "Let there be lights in the vault of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark sacred times, and days and years, <sup>15</sup>and let them be lights in the vault of the sky to give light on the earth." And it was so. <sup>16</sup>God made two great lights—the greater light to govern the day and the lesser light to govern the night. He also made the stars. <sup>17</sup>God set them in the vault of the sky to give light on the earth, <sup>18</sup>to govern the day and the night, and to separate light from darkness. And God saw that it was good. <sup>19</sup>And there was evening, and there was morning—the fourth day. <sup>20</sup>And God said, "Let the water teem with living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the vault of the sky." <sup>21</sup>So God created the great creatures of the sea and every living thing with which the water teems and that moves about in it, according to their kinds, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. <sup>22</sup>God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the water in the seas, and let the birds increase on the earth." <sup>23</sup>And there was evening, and there was morning—the fifth day.

<sup>24</sup>And God said, "Let the land produce living creatures according to their kinds: the livestock, the creatures that move along the ground, and the wild animals, each according to its kind." And it was so. <sup>25</sup>God made the wild animals according to their kinds, the livestock according to their kinds, and all the creatures that move along the ground according to their kinds. And God saw that it was good.

<sup>26</sup>Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground."

<sup>27</sup>So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.

<sup>28</sup>God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

<sup>29</sup>Then God said, "I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food. <sup>30</sup>And to all the beasts of the earth and all the birds in the sky and all the creatures that move along the ground—everything that has the breath of life in it—I give every green plant for food." And it was so.

<sup>31</sup>God saw all that he had made, and it was very good.

And there was evening, and there was morning—the sixth day.

<sup>1</sup>Thus the heavens and the earth were completed in all their vast array.

<sup>2</sup>By the seventh day God had finished the work he had been doing; so on the seventh day he rested from all his work. <sup>3</sup>Then God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work of creating that he had done.

Sermon

The Blessing of the Triune God

2 Corinthians 13:11-14

Stand

#### **Athanasian Creed**

- <sup>1</sup> Whoever wishes to be saved must, above all else, hold to the true Christian faith.
- <sup>2</sup> Whoever does not keep this faith pure in all points will certainly perish forever.
- <sup>3</sup> Now this is the true Christian faith:
- <sup>4</sup> We worship one God in Trinity and Trinity in Unity, without mixing the persons or dividing the divine being.
- <sup>5</sup> For each person—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—is distinct,
- <sup>6</sup> but the deity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one, equal in glory and coeternal in majesty.
- <sup>7</sup> What the Father is, so is the Son, and so is the Holy Spirit.
- <sup>8</sup> The Father is uncreated, the Son uncreated, the Holy Spirit uncreated;
- <sup>9</sup> the Father is infinite, the Son infinite, the Holy Spirit infinite;
- <sup>10</sup> the Father is eternal, the Son eternal, the Holy Spirit eternal;
- <sup>11</sup> yet they are not three who are eternal, but there is one who is eternal,
- <sup>12</sup> just as they are not three who are uncreated, nor three who are infinite, but there is one who is uncreated and one who is infinite.
- <sup>13</sup> In the same way the Father is almighty, the Son is almighty, the Holy Spirit is almighty;
- <sup>14</sup> yet they are not three who are almighty, but there is one who is almighty.
- <sup>15</sup> So the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God;
- <sup>16</sup> yet they are not three Gods, but one God.
- <sup>17</sup> So the Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, the Holy Spirit is Lord;
- <sup>18</sup> yet they are not three Lords, but one Lord.
- <sup>19</sup> For just as Christian truth compels us to confess each person individually to be God and Lord, so the true Christian faith forbids us to speak of three Gods or three Lords.
- <sup>20</sup> The Father is neither made nor created nor begotten of anyone.
- <sup>21</sup> The Son is neither made nor created, but is begotten of the Father alone.
- <sup>22</sup> The Holy Spirit is neither made nor created nor begotten, but proceeds from the Father and the Son.
- <sup>23</sup> So there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits.
- <sup>24</sup> And within this Trinity none comes before or after; none is greater or inferior;
- <sup>25</sup> but all three persons are coequal and coeternal, so that in every way, as stated before, the Trinity in Unity and Unity in Trinity is to be worshiped.
- <sup>26</sup> Whoever wishes to be saved must have this conviction of the Trinity.
- <sup>27</sup> It is furthermore necessary for eternal salvation that one faithfully believe that our Lord Jesus Christ also took on human flesh.
- <sup>28</sup> Now this is the true Christian faith: We believe and confess that our Lord Jesus Christ, God's Son, is both God and man.
- <sup>29</sup> He is God, eternally begotten from the nature of the Father, and he is man, born in time from the nature of his mother,

- <sup>30</sup> fully God, fully man, with rational soul and human flesh;
- <sup>31</sup> equal to the Father as to his deity, less than the Father as to his humanity;
- <sup>32</sup> and though he is both God and man, Christ is not two persons but one:
- <sup>33</sup> one, not by changing the deity into flesh, but by taking the humanity into God;
- <sup>34</sup> one, indeed, not by mixture of the natures, but by unity in one person;
- 35 for just as the rational soul and flesh is one human being, so God and man is one Christ.
- <sup>36</sup> He suffered for our salvation, descended into hell, rose the third day from the dead.
- <sup>37</sup> He ascended into heaven, is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, and from there will come to judge the living and the dead.
- <sup>38</sup> At his coming all people will rise with their own bodies to answer for their personal deeds.
- <sup>39</sup> Those who have done good will enter eternal life, but those who have done evil will go into eternal fire.
- <sup>40</sup> This is the true Christian faith. Whoever does not faithfully and firmly believe this cannot be saved.

Lord Jesus our Savior, you came into our world to make the Father known to us. You joined yourself to us by taking on our humanity and brought us back to God by shedding your blood. In love you walked the way of suffering and carried the wrath of God that we deserved because of our sins. Help us believe that all you did and all you endured you did to rescue us and set us free.

In the bright new hope of your resurrection teach us to offer our lives in praise to God and love to our neighbor.

Creator Spirit, you breathed into us new life by the power of the gospel, opened our eyes to see the light of your grace, and filled our minds with the clear sound of your voice. Through Word and sacrament lead us to understand more completely how broad and deep and high is the love of God in Christ Jesus. Firm up our resolve to do battle with Satan and sin.

In every weakness be our strength, that we may show ourselves to be God's children: faithful in prayer, constant in hope, and fervent in love.

Hear us, Lord, as we pray in silence.

#### **Words of Institution**


